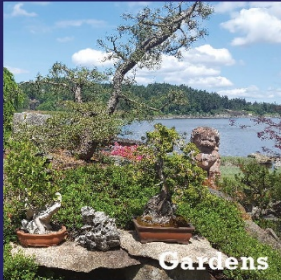


Golf

Outdoor Recreation

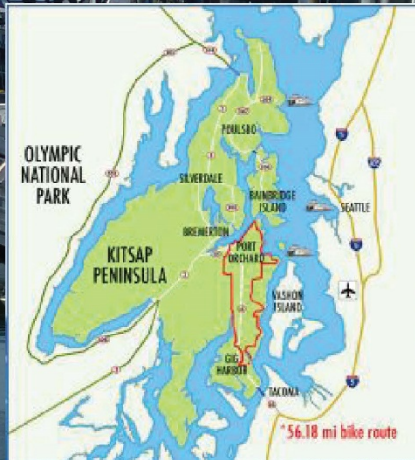

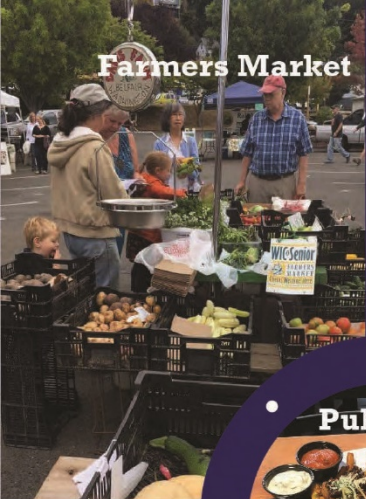
